We encourage our students to attend school everyday. If you need to take your child/children out of school during the term, for 5 days or over please contact the office so you can complete the application for extended leave - travel form.

School Attendance – SENTRAL app

Class rolls are marked every morning. If your child is marked absent you will receive a notification on SENTRAL for you to reply to so you can let us know the reason for the absence. If you want to let us know about an absence first thing in the morning you can put it up via the SENTRAL app without waiting for the notification. If we haven't heard from you by 11am an automated SMS message will come to your phone letting you know that we have marked your child absent and are waiting to hear from you.

Parent Transportation to events

With the sporting season heating up we are grateful for the assistance we receive from our parents and caregivers in transporting students to and from these events. It might be beneficial to note a few things about this – especially if you are asking someone else to transport your child.

For parents and caregivers who are providing transport we are required to check the following things:

- Declaration for Child-Related Workers form (available from the office) has been completed by person providing transport
- the driver is licenced
- the vehicle is registered
- we have sighted the driver's licence and car registration
- written permission from the parent or caregiver of the student being transported and by whom
