We also went through an exhibition where we saw the striped pyjamas that people had to wear in the concentration camps and a tea set which was a present to a daughter who also survived the holocaust. Both stories from Peter and Judy were emotional because Judy died at a young age because of hunger and Peter had to live in a wash house for several months. Our eyes were opened and we realised how horrible the Holocaust really was. All classes were praised on their behaviour on both days.

Although it was emotional experience, it was amazing and we would recommend going there. Thanks to all the teachers who took us there.

It was created to assist young children to build resilience, self-esteem and confidence and to learn important skills and techniques to cope with feelings of fear and worry. Each letter of the word FRIENDS helps children remember each of the skills taught throughout the program:

- F:** eelings
- R:** elax
- I:** can try
- E:** ncourage
- N:** uture
- D:** on't forget to be brave
- S:** tay calm

Children learn valuable skills such as:

- Kindness and empathy
- Identifying body clues and relaxation
- Changing "red" thoughts to "green" thoughts
- Making good choices and solution finding
