While we were there we heard stories from two Holocaust survivors, Peter and Judy. We also went through an exhibition where we saw the striped pyjamas that people had to wear in the concentration camps and a tea set which was a present to a daughter who also survived the holocaust. Both stories from Peter and Judy were emotional because Judy died at a young age because of hunger and Peter had to live in a wash house for several months. Our eyes were opened and we realised how horrible the Holocaust really was. All classes were praised on their behaviour on both days.

Although it was emotional experience, it was amazing and we would recommend going there. Thanks to all the teachers who took us there.
