### PREMIER'S SPORTING CHALLENGE

This year our school has registered to participate in the NSW Premier's Sporting Challenge. The purpose of the challenge is to encourage students to participate in sport and physical activity to lead a healthy lifestyle.

Over a ten week period, our school will be monitoring physical activity levels during class time, at recess and lunch as well as during sport lessons. Physical activity outside school hours will also count towards the Challenge award. The aim is to work towards an average at least 60 minutes of activity a day for ten weeks.

Our 2021 House Captains are our official PSC ambassadors and will be promoting the challenge throughout the school. This includes leading by example in the playground, helping set up physical education games and assisting teachers to enter student results on the website.

We would like to invite families to support us in encouraging students' healthy use of leisure time and to experience the joy of being active together. Each student in years 3-6 will be issued with a logbook to record their daily physical activity. K-2 students will work towards a Gold class award level. ### Week 4


Drawing a picture of something that you have made a decision about. Around the picture write or draw the feelings that you listened to in order to make your decision.
