School Bytes

This week we have moved over to a new payment method. Over the coming weeks, as you child has events to attend or payments to receive, you will be receiving an email to explain how this works. We will still send messages via the SENTRAL for Parents app. The email will provide you with a link to the School Bytes system which will have the permission note and the link to pay. The first events for this new system will be the upcoming Stage 2 Trent Barret Shield (Rugby League) & Aussie Rules Gala Days. If you receive an email please follow the link to the School Bytes Portal where you will need to register and it will then take you through to the permission note and payment section.

Building Update

Stage 2

This week we have had our inspection completed of four of the upstairs classrooms and they are safe for use. Over the next few days we will start to move tables and chairs up there for our Stage 2 & 5/6G students to use. We have ordered new student desks and they will arrive in the holidays. The classrooms will also be painted over the holidays as part of scheduled planned maintenance of the building. Stage 2 will be able to move back into their classrooms by Monday (if not earlier – depending on the lighting fixtures being installed this week).

Stage 3

Our Stage 3 students will return to us on Monday (28 August). 5/6G will return straight to their normal room while the other Stage 3 classes will be downstairs until after the carpet in their rooms is replaced in the holidays. Their classrooms are being painted next week and their new tables will arrive in the holidays.

Admin

The admin section is still closed off. Cleaning will begin in there next week now as will the fixing the floor. Please keep using our new admin entrance down in the Infants building if you need to pick up your child early.

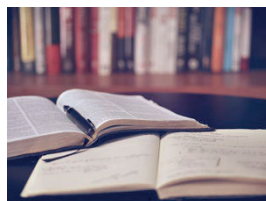

PROOF OF STUDENT'S RESIDENTIAL ADDRESS

100 Points Residential Proof Checklist Guidelines:

- All documents MUST be in the name of the enrolling parent / carer.
- At least ONE Category A and ONE Category B documents are required
- All documents must be current (dated within the last three months)

Lease agreement through a registered real estate agent for a period of at least 6 months or rental board bond receipt	40	
Exchanged Contract of Sale with settlement to occur within the applicable school year.	40

Centrelink payment statement showing home address	20	
Electoral roll statement showing home address	20	
Electricity or gas bill showing the service address	15	
Water bill showing the service address	15	
Telephone or Internet bill showing the service address	15	
Driver's licence or government issued ID showing home address	15	
Homebuilding or home contents insurance showing the service address.	15	
Motor vehicle registration or compulsory third party insurance policy showing home address	15	
Statutory declaration stating the child's residential address, how long they have lived there, and any supporting information or documentation of this	15

BIRTH CERTIFICATE OR IDENTIFYING DOCUMENT

IMMUNISATION REGISTER

Australian immunisation register (AIR) immunisation history statement (required for all students enrolling in NSW Government Schools for the first time).

4

FAMILY LAW OR COURT ORDERS

Copies of any family law or other relevant court orders

5

MEDICAL/ HEALTHCARE PLANS

Students with asthma or anaphylaxis require an ASCIA Action Plan from the doctor.

Students who take daily medication at school need a prescribed medical form.

6

DISABILITY OR SUPPORT NEEDS

Does your child have any support needs: (E.g. accessing speech therapy, occupational therapy, early intervention programs).

7

NON-AUSTRALIAN CITIZENS OR TEMPORARY VISA

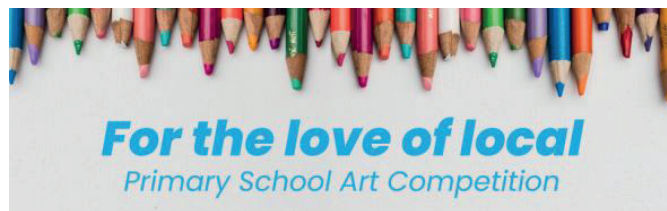
