#### **SASS Recognition Week**

#### **School Bytes**

#### **Building Update**

#### Stage 2

Last week 3/4S, 3/4C& 3/4F have all returned upstairs to their classrooms. This has provided a lot of joy and contentment at being back in their rooms. We have ordered new student desks and they will arrive in the first week of next term. The classrooms will also be painted over the holidays as part of scheduled planned maintenance of the building.
